Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC) Reader Rule Delayed

On December 23, 2022, the <u>James M. Inhofe National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2023 (H.R. 7776</u>) was signed into law, which includes section 11804(c) that delays implementation of Transportation Working Identification Credential (TWIC) Reader Requirements for **covered facilities** until at least May 8, 2026.

The term "covered facilities" means –

- (1) facilities that handle Certain Dangerous Cargoes in bulk and transfer such cargoes from or to a vessel;
- (2) facilities that handle Certain Dangerous Cargoes in bulk, but do not transfer from or to a vessel; and
- (3) facilities that receive vessels carrying Certain Dangerous Cargoes in bulk but, during the vessel-to-facility interface, do not transfer it from or to the vessel.

This new law takes precedent over the dates found in 33 CFR 105.253.
