Subject: Notice of Approval of East Coast Philadelphia, PA Centralized Examination Station (CES) Fee Schedule Change

Purpose: The purpose of this Public Bulletin is to provide notice to the trade community that U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) Philadelphia has approved changes to the East Coast Warehouse (Philadelphia) CES fee schedule in accordance with 19 C.F.R. 118.5.

Background: In Pipeline # 05-2024, dated December 21, 2023, CBP in the Area Port of Philadelphia published a notice regarding proposed fee schedule changes for East Coast CES in Philadelphia. In accordance with 19 C.F.R. 118.5, *Procedures for Changes to a Fee Schedule*, the public was invited to submit comments within 30 days of pipeline issuance. No public comments were received.

Approval: The below listed fee schedule changes are approved.

- 1. Chassis Fee \$40.00 / per day (Page 2)
- 2. Facility Fee \$175.00 / per exam (Page 5)
- 3. Refer Handling Surcharge \$50.00 / per day (Page 9)
- 4. Reefer Cargo Storage Charges \$135.00 / per day (days 1 4); \$245 / per day (days 5 or more) (Page 6)
- 5. Storage Charges \$135.00 per day (days 1-4); \$245.00 / per day (days 5 or more) (Page 8)
- 6. Shipment on Government Hold \$135.00 / per day (days 1 4); \$245.00 / per day (days 5 or more) (Page 8)

A copy of the East Coast Warehouse (Philadelphia) fee schedule is attached to this bulletin for reference.

As provided for in 19 C.F.R. 118.5, the CES Operator shall remain bound by the approved fee schedule and not implement any other changes to it prior to first obtaining written approval from the Port Director.
